

**“The Sword of the Spirit, the Word of God”
Only by the Armor of God are We Able to Overcome**

Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.

Ephesians 6:11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles [tricks] of the devil.

Acts 17:10-11 ¹⁰Then the brethren immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berēa. When they arrived, they went into the synagogue of the Jews. ¹¹These [Berēans] were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonīca, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to *find out* whether these things were so.

Acts 20:27 For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God.

Luke 4:13 Now when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from Him until an opportune time.

Hebrews 4:15-16 ¹⁵For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as *we are, yet* without sin. ¹⁶Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

Ephesians 6:13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Ephesians 6:14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness,

Ephesians 4:27 nor give place to the devil.

2 Timothy 2:3-4 ³You therefore must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. ⁴No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of *this* life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.

Ephesians 6:15-16 ¹⁵and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

Romans 8:31b If God is for us, who can be against us?

Ephesians 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God *is* living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Isaiah 59:17a For He put on righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of salvation on His head...

Luke 4:9-12 ⁹Then he brought Him to Jerusalem, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here. ¹⁰For it is written: '*He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you,*' and, ¹¹*'In their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone.'*" ¹²And Jesus answered and said to him, "It has been said '*You shall not tempt the LORD your God.*' "

2 Timothy 3:16a All Scripture *is* given by inspiration of God...

Ephesians 6:18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all saints—

1 Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing,

Philippians 4:6-7 ⁶Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; ⁷and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 6:19-20 ¹⁹and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel, ²⁰for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

Psalms 133:1 BEHOLD, how good and how pleasant *it is* for brethren to dwell together in unity!
