⁵⁸These *are* the families of the Lēvītes: the family of the Libnītes, the family of the Hēbronītes, the family of the Mahlītes, the family of the Mūshītes, and the family of the Kōhathītes. And Kohath begot Amram. ⁵⁹The name of Amram's wife *was* Jochebed the daughter of Levi, who was born to Levi in Egypt; and to Amram she bore Aaron and Moses and their sister Miriam. ⁶⁰To Aaron were born Nādab and Abīhū, Elēāzar and Ithamar.

Numbers 26:61-63

⁶¹And Nādab and Abīhū died when they offered profane fire before the LORD. ⁶²Now those who were numbered of them were twenty-three thousand, every male from a month old and above; for they were not numbered among the other children of Israel, because there was no inheritance given to them among the children of Israel. ⁶³These *are* those who were numbered by Moses and Elēāzar the priest, who numbered the children of Israel in the plains of Mōab by the Jordan, *across from Jericho*.

Deuteronomy 7:1a-4

“When the LORD your God brings you into the land which you go to possess, and has cast out many nations before you ... ²and when the LORD your God delivers them over to you, you shall conquer them *and* utterly destroy them. You shall make no covenant with them nor show mercy to them. ³Nor shall you make marriages with them.
