1st Line above each Book (below the Roman Emperor’s name) is the Anno Domini date each Book was written:
The approximate AD year each Book was written; i.e., 45-48 AD represents 45-48 years after Christ’s Incarnate Birth.

4th Line beneath each Book:

To see the approximate years the Books were written after our Lord’s death and resurrection, subtract the 33 years from His AD incarnate birth to His resurrection and subsequent ascension 40 days later—shown under the writers name.

Ten days after the Lord Jesus’ ascension, 50 days after His resurrection (Pentecost), He then sent the Holy Spirit to His chosen Apostles and about 120 disciples (Acts 1:15; 2:1-4). The Church Age began.

5th Line: Gives the location of where the Book was written.



Galatians 1:1-2

PAUL, an apostle (not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father who raised Him from the dead), ²and all the brethren who are with me,

To the churches of Galatia

Acts 1:23-24

²³And they proposed two: Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthiās. ²⁴And they prayed and said, You, O Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which of these two You have chosen.

Galatians 1:3-5

³Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ, ⁴who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, ⁵to whom *be* glory forever and ever. Amen.

Galatians 1:6-7

⁶I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel,
⁷which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ.

Galatians 1:8

But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed.

Deuteronomy 12:32

“Whatever I command you, be careful to observe it; you shall not add to it nor take away from it.”

Galatians 1:9

As we have said before, so now I say again,, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.

Galatians 1:10

For do I now persuade men, or God?
Or do I seek to please men? For if I
still pleased men, I would not be a
bondservant of Christ.

1 Thessalonians 2:4

But as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, even so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts.

Galatians 1:11-12

¹¹But I make known to you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man. ¹²For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught *it*, but *it came through the revelation of Jesus Christ*.

Galatians 1:13-14

¹³For you have heard of my former conduct in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God beyond measure and *tried to destroy it*. ¹⁴And I advanced in Judaism beyond many of my contemporaries in my own nation, being more exceedingly zealous for the traditions of my fathers.

Galatians 1:15-17

¹⁵But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb and called *me* through His grace, ¹⁶to reveal His Son in me, that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately confer with flesh and blood, ¹⁷nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those *who were* apostles before me; but I went to Arabia, and returned again to Damascus.

Galatians 1:18-19

¹⁸Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and remained with him fifteen days. ¹⁹But I saw none of the other apostles except James, the Lord's brother.

Galatians 1:20

(Now *concerning* the things which I write to you, indeed, before God, I do not lie.)

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”

Galatians 1:21

Afterward I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia.

Acts 13:1a, 2

Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers...
