

Israel After the Rapture
Jews were Jealous and Blinded but Some are Saved

Romans 11

Romans 10:19-21

¹⁹But I say, did Israel not know? First Moses says: *“I will provoke you to jealousy by those who are not a nation”* ²⁰But Isaiah is very bold and says: *“I was found by those who did not seek Me; I was made manifest to those who did not ask for Me.”* ²¹But to Israel he says: *“All day long I have stretched out My hands to a disobedient and contrary people.”*

Romans 11:1-3

I say then, has God cast away His people? Certainly not! For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. ²God has not cast away His people whom He foreknew. Or do you not know what the Scripture says of Elijah, how he pleads with God against Israel, saying, ³*“LORD, they have killed Your prophets and torn down Your altars, and I alone am left, and they seek my life”?*

Romans 11:4

But what does the divine response say to him?

“I have reserved for Myself seven thousand men who have not bowed down the knee to Bāal.” (1 Kings 19:18)

Romans 10:3

For they being ignorant of God's righteousness have not submitted to the righteousness of God.

Romans 11:5

Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election of grace.

Romans 11:6-7

⁶And if by grace, then *it is* no longer of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if *it is* of works, it is no longer grace; otherwise work is no longer work. ⁷What then? Israel has not obtained what it seeks; but the elect have obtained it, and the rest were blinded.

Romans 11:8-10

⁸Just as it is written” “*God has given them a spirit of stupor, eyes that they should not see and ears that they should not hear, to this very day.*” ⁹And David says: “*Let their table become a snare and a trap, a stumbling block and a recompense to them.*” ¹⁰Let their eyes be darkened, so that they do not see, and bow down their back always.”

Matthew 27:25

And all the people answered and said, “His blood be on us and on our children.”

Romans 11:11-12

¹¹I say then, have they stumbled that they should not fall? Certainly not! But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation *has come* to the Gentiles. ¹²Now if their fall is riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness!

Romans 11:13-15

¹³For I speak to you Gentiles; inasmuch as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry, ¹⁴if by any means I may provoke to jealousy *those who are* my flesh and save some of them. ¹⁵For if their being cast away *is* the reconciling of the world, what *will* their acceptance *be* but life from the dead?

Romans 11:16-18

¹⁶For if the firstfruit *is* holy, the lump *is* also *holy*; and if the root *is* holy, so *are* the branches. ¹⁷And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, ¹⁸do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, *remember that* you do not support the root, but the root supports you.

“But the Gentiles should not take a holier-than-thou attitude toward the Jews, or **boast** of any superiority. Any such boasting overlooks the fact that they didn’t originate the line of privilege. Rather, it is a line of privilege that put them where they are, in a place of special favor.”

Romans 11:19-24

¹⁹You will say then, “Branches were broken off that I might be grafted in.” ²⁰Well *said*, Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear. ²¹For if God did not spare the natural branches, He may not spare you either. ²²Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God; on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in *His* goodness. Otherwise you will also be cut off. ²³And they also, if they do not continue in unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again. ²⁴For if you were cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, who *are* natural *branches*, be grafted into their own olive tree?

1 Thessalonians 4:13

But I do not want you to be ignorant brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope.

Romans 11:25-27

²⁵For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. ²⁶And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: “*The Deliverer will come out of Zion, and He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob;* ²⁷*For this is My covenant with them, when I take away their sins.*”

Romans 11:30-32

³⁰For as you were once disobedient to God, yet have now obtained mercy through their disobedience, ³¹even so these also have now been disobedient, that through the mercy shown you they also may obtain mercy. ³²For God has committed them all to disobedience, that He might have mercy on all.

Romans 11:33
