

Israel in Today's Church Age

Deuteronomy 32:5, 16-21 ⁵“They have corrupted themselves; they are not His children, because of their blemish; a perverse and crooked nation.” ... ¹⁶“They provoked Him to jealousy with foreign gods; with abominations [detestable acts] they provoked Him to anger. ¹⁷They sacrificed to demons, not to God, *to gods* they did not know, to new gods, new arrivals that your fathers did not fear. ¹⁸Of the Rock *who* begot you, you are unmindful, and have forgotten the God who fathered you. ¹⁹And when the LORD saw *it*, He spurned [abhorred/detested] *them*, because of the provocation of His sons and daughters. ²⁰And He said: “I will hide My face from them, I will see what their end *will be*, for they *are* a perverse generation, children in whom *is* no faith. ²¹They have provoked Me to jealousy by *what* is not God; they have moved Me to anger by their foolish idols. But I will provoke *them* to jealousy by those who are not a nation; I will move them to anger by a foolish nation.”

Romans 10:1-4 Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved. ²For I bear witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to *knowledge*. ³For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God. ⁴For Christ *is* the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

Romans 3:20-21 ²⁰Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law *is* the *knowledge of sin*. ²¹But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the law and the Prophets.

Exodus 30:10 “And Aaron shall make atonement upon its horns once a year with the blood of the sin offering of atonement; once a year he shall make atonement upon it throughout your generations. It is most holy to the LORD.”

Leviticus 17:11 “For the life of the flesh *is* in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it *is* the blood *that* makes atonement for the soul.”

Hebrews 9:22 And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.

Leviticus 22:21a, c ^{21a}“And whoever offers a sacrifice... ^{21c}it must be perfect to be accepted; there shall be no defect in it.”

Isaiah 51:5a “My righteousness is near, My salvation has gone forth, and My arms will judge the peoples.”

Romans 3:20b-21 ^{20b}by the law *is* the *knowledge of sin*: ²¹But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the law and the Prophets.

Romans 3:22a even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe.

Romans 10:5 For Moses writes about the righteousness which is of the law. “*The man who does those things shall live by them.*”

Romans 10:6-7 ⁶But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, “Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’” (that is, to bring Christ down *from* above). ⁷or “Who will descend into the abyss?’” (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).

Romans 10:8-9 ⁸But what does it say? “*The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart*” (that is, the word of faith which we preach): ⁹that if you confess with your mouth the lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 10:10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

1 John 4:19 We love Him because He first loved us.

Jeremiah 17:10 “I, the LORD, search the heart, *I test* the mind, even to give to every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his doings.”

Romans 10:11 For the Scripture says, “*Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame*”

Jeremiah 6:19 “Hear, O earth! Behold, I will certainly bring calamity on this people—the fruit of their thoughts, because they have not heeded My words, nor My law, but rejected it.”

Romans 10:12-13 ¹²For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. ¹³For “*whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.*”

Mark 1:15b “Repent, and believe in the gospel.”

Romans 10:14-15 ¹⁴How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? ¹⁵And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “*How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things!*”

1 Samuel 3:7 (Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, nor was the word of the LORD yet revealed to him.)

1 Samuel 3:16-19 ¹⁶Then Eli called Samuel and said, “Samuel, my son!” He answered, “Here I am.” ¹⁷And he said, “What *is* the word that *the LORD* spoke to you? Please do not hide *it* from me. God do so to you, and more also, if you hide anything from me of all the things that He said to you.” ¹⁸Then Samuel told him everything, and hid nothing from him. And he said, “*It is the LORD. Let Him do what seems good to Him.*” ¹⁹So Samuel grew. And the LORD was with him and let none of his words fall to the ground.

1 Peter 4:17 For the time *has come* for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if *it begins* with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God?

Romans 10:16 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, “*LORD, who has believed our report?*”

Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

1 Corinthians 2:14 But the natural [unsaved] man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

Ephesians 1: 16b-18a ^{16b}I mention you in my prayers; ¹⁷that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, ^{18a}the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of his calling,

Romans 10:18 But I say, have they not heard? Yes indeed: “*Their sound has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world.*”

Romans 10:19 But I say, did Israel not know? First Moses says: “*I will provoke you to jealousy by those who are not a nation; I will move you to anger by a foolish nation.*”

Titus 3:3 For we ourselves were also once foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another.

Romans 10:20 But Isaiah is very bold and says: “*I was found by those who did not seek Me; I was made manifest [revealed] to those who did not ask for Me.*”

Ephesians 4:16-18 ¹⁶For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷Then we who are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. ¹⁸Therefore comfort one another with these words.

Romans 10:21 But to Israel he says: “*All day long I have stretched out My hands to a disobedient and contrary people.*”
