

# Sacrifices and Burnt Offerings?

Hebrews 10

## Hebrews 10:1

For the law, having a shadow of good things to come, *and* not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect.

## **Hebrews 10:2**

For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins.

## Hebrews 10:3-4

<sup>3</sup>But in those *sacrifices there is* a reminder of sins every year. <sup>4</sup>For *it is not possible* that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins.

## Hebrews 10:5-7

<sup>5</sup>Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: “*Sacrifice and offering You do not desire, but a body You have prepared for Me.*”  
<sup>6</sup>*In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure.* <sup>7</sup>*Then I said, ‘Behold, I have come—in the volume of the book it is written of Me—to do Your will O God.’ ”*

## **Hebrews 10:8**

Previously saying, “*Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure in them*”  
(Which are offered according to the law),

## **Hebrews 10:9**

then He said, “*Behold, I have come to do Your will O God.*” He takes away the first that He may establish the second.

## **Hebrews 10:10**

By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *for all*.

## **Hebrews 10:11**

And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.

## **Hebrews 10:12-13**

<sup>12</sup>But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God, <sup>13</sup>from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool.

## **Psalm 110:1**

THE LORD said to My Lord, “Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool.”

## **Hebrews 10:14**

For by one offering He has perfected  
forever those who are being sanctified.

## **Romans 8:38-39**

<sup>38</sup>For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, <sup>39</sup>nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

## **John 10:28-30**

<sup>28</sup>“And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish, neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. <sup>29</sup>My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of My Father’s hand. <sup>30</sup>I and My Father are one.”

## Hebrews 10:15-18

<sup>15</sup>But the Holy Spirit also witnesses to us; for after He had said before, <sup>16</sup>*“This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the LORD; I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them.”* <sup>17</sup>Then He adds, *“Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more.”* <sup>18</sup>Now where there is remission of these, *there is no longer an offering for sin.*

## **Hebrews 10:19-20**

<sup>19</sup>Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, <sup>20</sup>by a new [sacrifice] and living way [resurrected Savior] which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh,

## **Hebrews 10:21-22**

<sup>21</sup>and *having* a High Priest over the house of God, <sup>22</sup>let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

## Hebrews 10:23-25

<sup>23</sup>Let us hold fast the confession of *our* hope without wavering, for He who promised *is* faithful. <sup>24</sup>And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, <sup>25</sup>not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but *exhorting one another,* and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

## **Hebrews 10:26-27**

<sup>26</sup>For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, <sup>27</sup>but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries.

## Hebrews 10:28-29

<sup>28</sup>Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on *the testimony of* two or three witnesses. <sup>29</sup>Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?

## Hebrews 10:30-31

<sup>30</sup>For we know Him who said, “*Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,*” says the Lord. And again, “*The LORD will judge His people.*”

<sup>31</sup>It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

## Hebrews 10:32-33

<sup>32</sup>But recall the former days in which, after you were illuminated, you endured a great struggle with sufferings: <sup>33</sup>partly while you were made a spectacle both by reproaches and tribulations, and partly while you became companions of those [other persecuted Christians] who were so treated;

## **Hebrews 10:34-35**

<sup>34</sup>for you had compassion on me in my chains, and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods, knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in heaven.

<sup>35</sup>Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward.

## Hebrews 10:36-38

<sup>36</sup>For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise: <sup>37</sup>*For yet a little while, and He who is coming will come and will not tarry.* <sup>38</sup>*Now the just shall live by faith; but if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.”*

## **Hebrews 10:39**

But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who **believe** to the saving of the soul.

## **Joel 2:32a**

And it shall come to pass *that* whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.

## **Acts 2:21**

*‘And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.’*

## **Romans 10:13**

For “*whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.*”

## **Ezekiel 36:26-27**

<sup>26</sup>“I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. <sup>27</sup>I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.”

## **Psalm 118:17**

I shall not die, but live, and declare  
the works of the LORD.
